CCTNS project along with the Citizen Portal <http://eservices.tnpolice.gov.in> has been inaugurated by the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu on 13.03.2013 in Thiruvallur, Ariyalur, Sivagangai districts and Coimbatore commissionerate. Hence, the following shall be ensured in the police stations:-

- i) Computer generated CSR receipts using CIPRUS software should be issued to the petitioner.
- ii) As and when the petition is disposed, nature of disposal of the CSR should be updated on the same day.
- iii) All UI and PT cases progress should be updated without delay.
- iv) A team under District Special Branch should be formed to monitor the online information/complaints sent by public on daily basis.
- v) Fortnightly report should be sent on the action taken on the information/complaints.
