As you are aware, the Crime and Criminal Tracking Network and Systems (CCTNS) has been approved as one of the Mission Mode Projects (MMPs) under the National e-Governance Plan (NeGP) and it aims at creating a comprehensive and integrated system for enhancing the efficiency and effectiveness of policing through adoption of principles of e-Governance and creation of a Nationwide networking infrastructure. The Hon'ble Chief Minister had inaugurated the CCTNS project along with Citizen Portal in Tiruvallur, Ariyalur and Sivagangai Districts and Coimbatore Commissionerate on 13.03.2013 and the implementation in the remaining 30 Districts and 5 Commissionerates was completed on 30.09.2013 and the citizen portal, (i.e.), <a href="http://eservices.tnpolice.gov.ir/">http://eservices.tnpolice.gov.ir/</a>, was enabled to public for sending online complaints.

- 2. Further, the Police Department has been included as one of the 15 Government Departments for providing e-services through Common Service Centre (CSC) and this facility was launched by the Hon'ble Chief Minister on 24.02.2014.

During the review of the project in the State Apex Committee Meeting on 08.01.2014, the Chief Secretary desired to create more awareness and publicity regarding the services available in the Citizen Portal. I am, therefore, to request you kindly to create more awareness and publicity regarding the CCTNS Citizen Portal (<a href="http://eservices.tinpolice.gov.in/">http://eservices.tinpolice.gov.in/</a>) and also to review the progress of online complaints in the monthly Law and Order Meeting with the Superintendents of Police, as part of e-governance initiative in the districts.
